


Figure 1.0: This figure reflects the enrollments of the U.S. population in kindergarten, elementary and high school during 1985, 1995 and 2005. Source: U.S. Census Bureau (www.census.org).

Figure 1.0 displays the total U.S. population (in thousands) enrolled in Kindergarten, Elementary and High School in 1985, 1995 and 2005. As seen in the chart, the majority of those enrolled in K-12 from 1985 thorough 2005 were enrolled in elementary schools. The lowest enrollments occurred in kindergarten throughout this time period.

The raw data listed in *Table 1.0* illustrates the number of individuals in the U.S. enrolled in kindergarten, elementary school and high school. The largest increase in enrollments occurred in

elementary school from 1985 to 1995 at 18.25% growth. The smallest increase in enrollments occurred in kindergarten from 1995 to 2005 at .9% growth.
